Dear Beloved in Christ,

"Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ"



October 2nd, we are celebrating Youth Day. Youths are living in a world of challenges and pseudo culture. The Bible has several stories of young people who obeyed the call of God and used their strength and talents in the service of the community. Jesus called twelve young people and later seventy with different gifts and talents, trained them in preaching the gospel and in continuing his ministry in the world. In the early Church young people joined as assistants to the apostles and preachers of the gospel helping them in every way. Mark, Luke, Timothy, Silas, Titus and others. Even Onesimus, the young slave who ran away from his master seems to have assisted Paul in the prison. St. John in his first Epistle, specially addresses young people and says they are strong, the Word of God abides in them, and they have overcome the evil one.

The whole missionary enterprise started as a youth movement at Universities, Colleges and Churches. The pietistic movement captured the imagination of young people to go out into unknown lands and communities, taking the gospel of Jesus for the salvation of the whole world. Missionaries like Ziegenbalg, Plutschau and Schwartz in Tranquebar; Carey, Marshman and Ward in Serampore and Ida Scudder of Vellore were young people, inspired to commit their lives to the Lord and his Gospel. Bishop Azariah of Dornakal received his missionary call as a young man. Sadhu Sundar Singh, Pandita Rama Bai, Rev. K. E. Eapen (Pioneer missionary of Parkal mission) and a host of young people in different parts of our country received their call and committed their lives to the different ministries. Ecclesiastes chapter 12 begins with a warning to the young people to remember their Creator. But often youths are attracted to the charisma of this world and their life becomes like the prodigal son referred in Luke 15:11-16. Here in this portion verse 17 onwards shows the repentance leading him to the realization of father's love and real life. Dear beloved in Christ, a 'U' turn is needed in your life, if you have not realized the love of God and richness of life. So let's not hesitate to face if problems, agonies, and trials come. These are the rich experiences that make you perfect. I would like to appreciate our youth fellowship members for their enthusiasm and creativity in doing things. Thanks to all the youth members for their effort to make the 'Snehasangamam' a big success. This month we have Annual Church Convention from Oct.4-8 at NECK.
